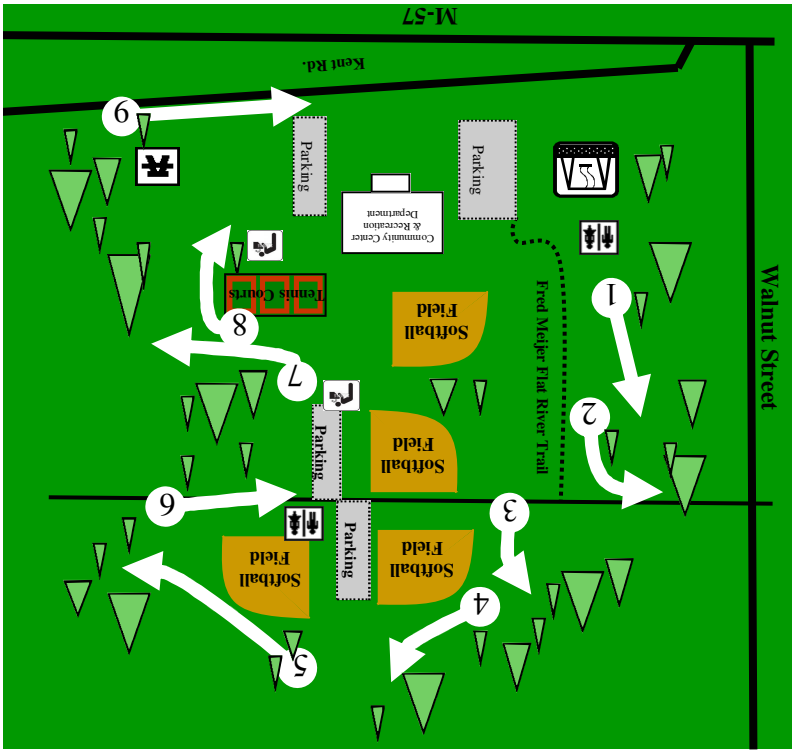

General Rules:

- One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The object is to acquire the lowest score.
- Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area. Do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range.
- The areas that are considered out-of-bounds are: softball fields, tennis court and the road next to hole 9. A disc that lands O.B. must be brought back into play and counts as a penalty throw, adding 1 point to your score.
- Complete disc golf rules can be found at the kiosk before hole 1.
