Special Features

Two lakes provide the most water holes in NC and the most I've ever played on any course. The water (and wind) creates tons of Risk vs. Reward holes so you really have to think and be accurate.

Favorite Hole(s)

17 Green- a unique wooded island hole that's long, but only 90 ft from front to back with that basket about 50 ft. from the front edge. 14. The lake is all along the left side to a peninsula green.

Miscellaneous

The wind over the water can be brutal. One time I played the wind was ~30 mph. Drew Short & Chuck Connelly helped with some aspects of the design.

If you like water holes then you've arrived in paradise! With water on 13 holes this is a beautiful, fun, and unique course; just make sure to bring some extra discs and disc retrievers with you.
