

Game play & rules

Tee off: When teeing off, one must stand in or behind the tee box in order for the throw to be valid on the first throw. After that, one must stand behind the basket.

Throwing order: After teeing off, the player whose disc is the farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole.

Out of bounds: Out of bounds (a.k.a. OB) is when your disc lands on or outside a permanent water hazard or barrier. If the disk lands OB, you must add a penalty stroke to your score.

Fairway throws: Where your disc lands is called the lie. When throwing, the front foot may not pass the lie point.

Putting: You finish each hole by putting. The disc you throw may land in the chains or basket, but not on the basket.

Scoring: Disc golf is the same as ball golf in the sense of scoring. Every throw counts as a stroke. When finished putting, add up the strokes for the total score.
