





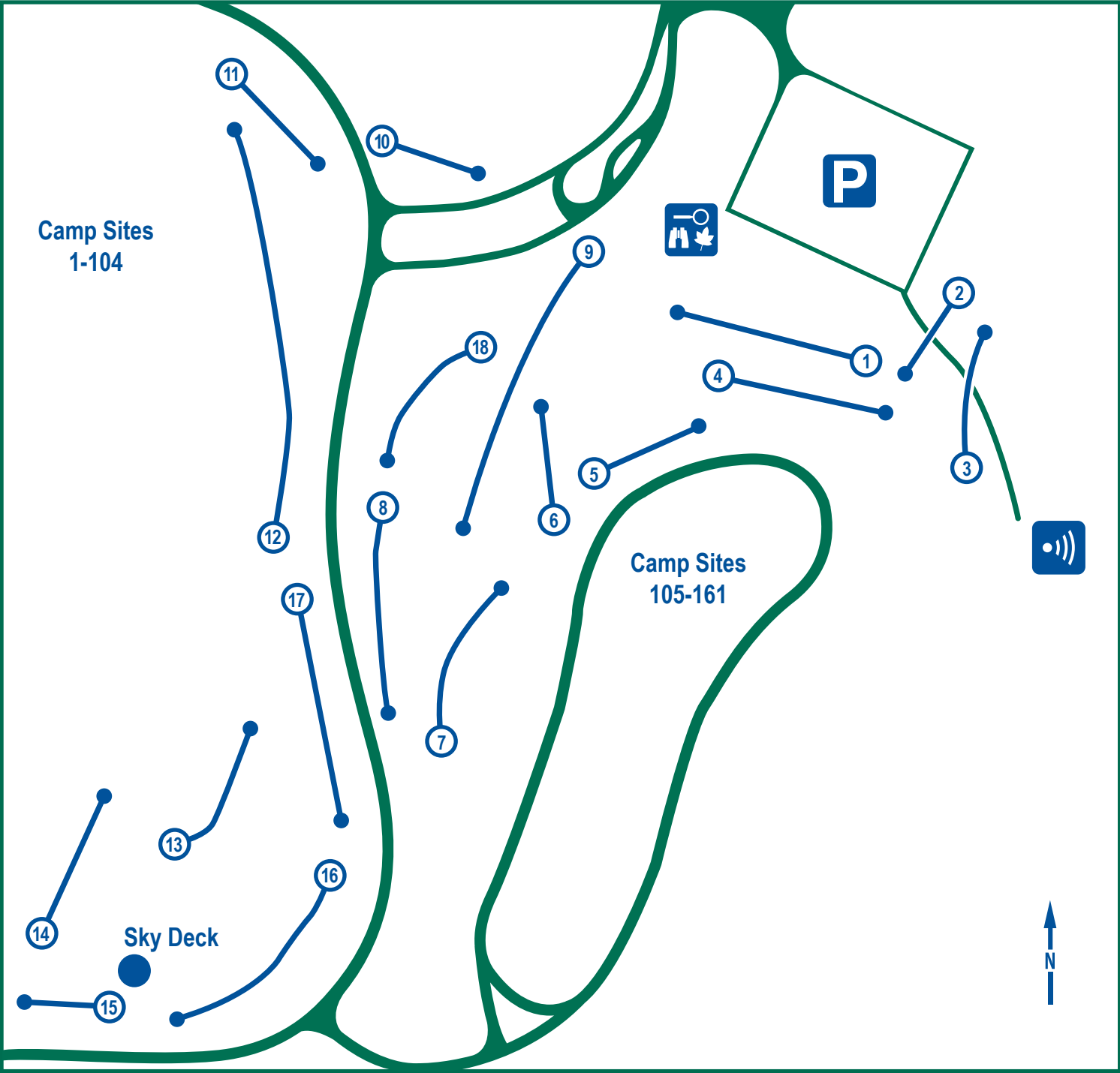

Nestled in the rolling hills just behind the camp store at Dillon State Park, this full eighteen hole course offers a variety of challenges for both young and old alike, experienced or not. The course is available for anyone to play, even if you are not staying at the park. You'll find holes that are in open fields, wooded areas and some that are completely hidden from the tee for an extra challenge.

Please visit our camp store for rental discs, or to purchase discs, and while you're there, check out all of the other fine offerings that are available for your enjoyment. Have a cold drink, some home-made fudge, or even an ice cream cone!

While you are playing, keep an eye out for some of Ohio's magnificent wildlife! White-tailed deer, raccoons, skunks, rabbits, hawks and of course, the woodchuck may all be seen in this area!

Disc Golf Rules

- Disc golf is played like regular golf, only using flying discs. One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown, and when a penalty is incurred. The winner is the golfer with the lowest score.
- Tee throws must be completed behind the designated tee markers. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the fewest throws on the previous hole is first to tee off on the next.
- Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the spot where the last throw came to rest.
- A run-up and normal follow thru is allowed if you are more than 10 meters (approx. 30 feet) from the hole. Less than 10 meters from the hole, the player must throw from where the disc lies.
- A disc that comes to rest inside of the basket constitutes successful completion of the hole.
- For the safety of others in the park, please be patient and wait your turn.
- Be extra cautious of horses and pedestrians at trail crossings.
- Be alert and courteous to other park users.
- Help protect, beautify and conserve our park and natural areas by picking up litter and not harming the native vegetation, and please don't feed the wild animals!
- Please take all trash with you to the camp store to throw away when you leave.
