

Disc Golf Rules

1. Disc Golf is played like regular golf, only using flying discs. One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown, and also when a penalty is incurred. The winner is the golfer with the lowest score. Please play in groups of 4-6 per game.
2. Starting Tee throws must be made within 3 feet of the marked "T" pole. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the disc catcher always throws first. The player with the fewest strokes on the previous hole is the first to tee off.
3. Throws must be made with both feet on or behind the spot where the last throw landed.
4. A disc that lands in the catcher is a successful completion of that hole.
5. A disc that lands more than 2 ft. above the ground (in a tree or on a roof) is considered unplayable and one stroke penalty will be incurred. A disc that lands on a roadway or parking lot is one stroke penalty. A disc that strikes a building, vehicle, person or crosses any fence will incur one stroke penalty. A player must re-throw their disc from the previous landing spot after any penalty.
6. Never throw until the players ahead of you are out of range, and until the throwing area is clear of other people and/or vehicles.
7. The maximum strokes for one hole is 10.
8. Enjoy your game of disc golf! If you would like to enter our score competition, sign your score sheet and submit it to the camp office.
