## RULES & GAMEPLAY

### disc golf

Disc golf is played like golf, using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The object is to acquire the lowest score. For the Professional Disc Golf Association official rules and competition manual, visit [www.pdga.com](http://www.pdga.com).

### game play

Never throw until the players ahead of you are out of range. Tee throws must be made within or behind the teeing areas.

After teeing off, the player whose disc is the farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is first to tee off on the next hole.

A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed more than ten meters from the hole. Inside ten meters, a player may not step past the point of their lie until after the disc has landed.

### out-of-bounds

Any disc that comes to rest more than two meters above the ground is considered out-of-bounds. The next throw must be taken from directly below the disc, and the player receives a one-stroke penalty.

A disc that is thrown out-of-bounds (on or over a bike path or road, or surrounded by water) must be thrown from the point where it went out-of-bounds.

### hole completion

A disc that comes to rest inside the basket or chains constitutes successful completion of that hole. A disc that comes to rest on top of the basket does not.

### park rules

Vehicle entry and disc golf permits are required at all times. Daily wristbands may be purchased on-site at the disc golf course May through September, and at the park entry tollbooth and park office year-round. All annual bag tags must be purchased at the park office.

### general information

Please respect all vegetation and trees. Intentionally destroying vegetation or trees is prohibited in the official disc golf rules of play. It goes against the spirit of the game and may result in you being evicted from the park and receiving a ticket for vandalism.

Littering, including cigarette butts and beverage containers, is considered a rules violation (one-stroke penalty). This is your disc golf course; please help keep it clean.
