Holes 12-17 are in an arboretum. The baskets have large hole numbers stuck on poles in the middle that make it much easier to see the basket. There is lush, well manicured grass on some back nine holes.

11. It's got very nice grass with some trees, downhill, 237 ft for a really fun ace run. My practice shot hit the chains so that adds to my good feelings.

## Miscellaneous

On the grassy part of hole 9, down the hill, I had to tell a girls' cheeleading class and their moms to watch out for disc golfers because they were in a blind spot in the middle of the fairway!

## Comments

There's an awful lot to like about this course and very few improvements needed. There aren't stellar holes, but a whole lot of really good ones. I'd play here often if I lived closer.
