WELCOME TO THE MACATAWA GREENSPACE DISC GOLF COURSE

DISC GOLF IS A FUN AND CHALLENGING SPORT FOR PEOPLE OF ALL AGES. LIKE REGULAR BALL GOLF, THE OBJECT OF DISC GOLF IS TO PLAY EACH HOLE IN THE FEWEST NUMBER OF THROWS (STROKES) POSSIBLE. THE PLAYER WITH THE LOWEST TOTAL THROWS FOR THE 18-HOLE COURSE IS THE WINNER. PAR FOR THE 18 HOLE COURSE IS 57.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES SO THAT THIS PARK CAN BE ENJOYED BY ALL PARK VISITORS:

BASIC RULES OF PLAY

- EACH HOLE BEGINS AT THE CONCRETE TEE PAD. SUBSEQUENT THROWS ARE MADE FROM THE PLACE WHERE THE DISC COMES TO REST (THE LIE).
- THE PLAYER WHO IS FURTHEST FROM THE TARGET THROWS FIRST.
- THE HOLE IS COMPLETED WHEN THE DISC IS SUPPORTED BY THE TARGET'S BASKET.
- TEE OFF ORDER IS DETERMINED BY PLAYERS SCORES ON THE PREVIOUS HOLE. LOWEST SCORE TEES FIRST.
- STAND BEHIND THE PLAYER WHO IS THROWING UNTIL THE THROW IS COMPLETE.
- REMOVE DISC FROM TARGET AFTER COMPLETING THE HOLE.
- A PLAYER MUST HAVE A SUPPORTING POINT BEHIND HIS LIE AND IN LINE WITH THE TARGET WHEN THE DISC IS RELEASED.
- A RUN UP AND FOLLOW THROUGH ARE ALLOWED UNLESS THE LIE IS WITHIN 10 METERS OF THE TARGET.
- ANY SHOT WITHIN 10 METERS OF THE TARGET REQUIRES THAT THE PLAYER NOT MOVE PAST HIS LIE UNTIL THE DISC IS AT REST.
- CASUAL RELIEF SHOULD BE TAKEN FROM AN UNSAFE LIE.
- ALLOW FASTER GROUPS TO PLAY THROUGH WHEN POSSIBLE.

GENERAL PARK AND COURSE RULES

- ALL OTTAWA COUNTY PARKS RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE IN AFFECT AT ALL TIMES.
- ALCOHOL IS NOT ALLOWED IN ANY AREA OF THE PARK OR COURSE.
- PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE COURSE.
- GOLFERS MUST SHOW COURTESY TO NON-GOLFERS. DO NOT THROW WHEN TRAIL WALKERS OR OTHER PARK USERS ARE NEARBY. TRAIL USERS HAVE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY.
- RESPECT OTHER GOLFERS AND PARK USERS BY REFRAINING FROM PLAYING LOUD MUSIC, YELLING OBSCENITIES, OR ANY OTHER OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOR.
- PUT TRASH IN ITS PROPER RECEPTACLES.
- ALTERING OR VANDALIZING TARGETS, SIGNS, PARK EQUIPMENT, AND LANDSCAPING IS A SERIOUS OFFENSE AND WILL BE PROSECUTED.
