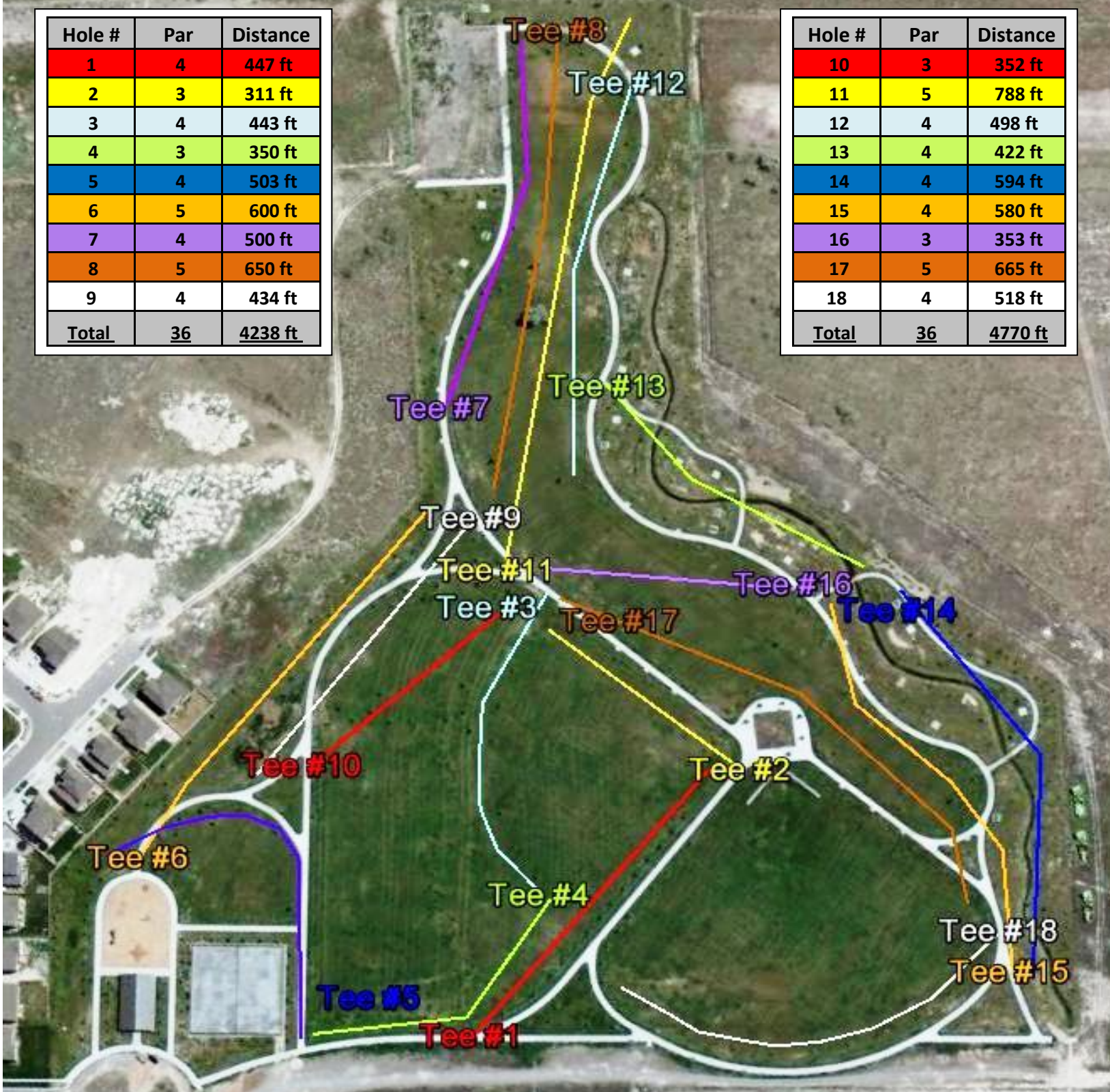

Course Rules

1. This is a multipurpose park. People on the course, whether players or non-players, have the right of way. Please be considerate. Hitting another person is a 3 stroke penalty.
2. Regular PDGA disc golf rules apply. The player with the fewest total throws to complete the course wins. After the tee shot, the player furthest from the hole throws first. The player with the lowest score, from the previous hole, tees off first.
3. Run-ups are allowed on tee shots, but the disc must be released within the marked tee box.
4. Play on each hole is not complete until the disc is in the basket.
5. All man-made facilities in the park, such as, cement walks, playgrounds, tennis courts, picnic tables, pavilions and parking lots, are considered out of bounds and incur a 2 stroke penalty, if your disc comes to rest on them.
6. If you cannot successfully complete play on a hole without interfering with a scheduled athletic or group event, you must skip play on that hole. Discs thrown onto fields where athletic events are taking place are considered lost and must be abandoned.
7. Discs thrown into private back yards are considered lost and must be abandoned. Entering a private yard is considered trespassing and may be punishable by law.
8. For tournament play, official PDGA rules shall supersede any local course rules.
