

Additional OB's specific to the Waynesville Disc Golf Course...

- #1 OB Parking lot & beyond fence
- #2 OB Horse Park, gravel/left up to the bridge
- #3 OB Dog Park
- #4 OB Railroad gravel/left, dog park,
- #5 OB Railroad gravel/left, pathway/right, pavilion, playground, beyond fence
- #6 OB Fence left, Tennis Courts, beyond maintenance shed & roof
- #7 OB Fence/left to creek, road, (short) beyond creek, (long) Creek/left to hole
- #8 OB Road/right, Horse park/left, (including concrete under pavilion)
- #9 OB Ball-field
- #10 OB Ball-field
- #11 OB Beyond fence & ball-field
- #12 OB Fence/left & volleyball court
- #13 OB Volleyball court, road/left, high grass (weeds)
- #14 OB Roof of Building, junkyard, pathway/over
- #15 OB Track/left, parking lot
- #16 OB ALL asphalt (both tee-box positions)
- #17 OB Creek (rocks surrounded by water), pathway
- #18 OB Pathway/left & over by the pin

WHAT CLASSIFIES A LIE AS BEING OUT OF BOUNDS?

- PDGA 803.09 – A disc shall be considered out of bounds only when it comes to rest and it is clearly and completely surrounded by the out of bounds area.
 - If your disc is lying $\frac{1}{2}$ grass – $\frac{1}{2}$ pathway, then you are NOT OB
 - If your disc is leaning onto the fairway side of a fence that is OB, you are NOT OB because your disc isn't totally surrounded inside the fence. However, if your disc is inside the fence and leaning, then it is OB.

**If your disc lies in a tree, as long as it is in-bounds – place the lie directly beneath and behind the tree. If the lie of the disc is over 6' in height from the base of the tree, then it is a 1 stroke penalty.
