

DISC GOLF RULES FOR RECREATIONAL PLAY

Disc Golf is played like ball golf using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown. The object is to acquire the lowest score.

TEE THROWS

Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area. Do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range.

LIE

The spot where the previous throw has landed, mark with a mini disc or turn over the thrown disc, directly towards the hole or dog leg.

THROWING ORDER

After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole.

FAIRWAY THROWS

Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the lie. The other foot may be no closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed. (Except within 10 meters of the basket)

COMPLETION OF HOLE

A disc that comes to rest in the basket constitutes successful completion of that hole. A disc that comes to rest on top of the basket is **NOT** in.

UN-PLAYABLE LIE

Any disc that comes to rest above the ground is considered an un-playable lie. The disc must be thrown from the lie on the ground, directly underneath the un-playable lie. Relocated to avoid damage to the vegetation.

COURSE COURTESY

- * Please pick up trash and use the trash cans provided throughout the course.
 - * Be courteous to other players you may meet on the course.
 - * Do not cut or damage any vegetation on the course.
 - * If you find a disc in the woods, and it has a name on it, please contact the owner. The next disc found in a similar manner could be yours.
 - * Report any vandalism or misconduct to Whitehall Township

Whitehall Township Disc Golf Course

Encompassing nearly twenty-five acres, this 18 hole professionally designed course is situated on gently sloping terrain among beautiful oak and pine trees. With nearly 5,000 feet of fairways, this course is sure to provide just enough challenge to keep all levels of playing abilities coming back for more. The course was designed to ensure all playing styles and levels would be accommodated. There are right, left, and straight on shots, as well as several holes over 300 feet, and many shorter, technical holes. Tee areas are marked with posts and signs, and the targets are yellow Innova DISCatcher baskets. Summer leagues are available.
