

Carousel Park hole by hole breakdown:

Hole 1 can easily eat your disc with thorns on the left and water on the right.

Water in play on hole 2 (A 420 B 525).

Hole 3 is a 500 foot straight down hill shot.

Hole 4 is a '380 foot monster that plays like 450 with a steep elevation increase in front of the tee and when you get to the top you have to throw up a slight elevation change.

Hole 5. Basket is way to the left hidden in the brush.

Hole 6: an unforgettable tee pad. The tee pad was muddy and slippery, if you foot fault you will end up in the creek. You have to throw up a hill, but trees block a high flight path. From hole 6 do not turn into the dog park.

7 is a 420' shot thought the trees into an open putting area.

Hole 8 is a 790 footer with thorns and trees on the left. Equestrian equipment provide some small obstacles. Basket is tucked into the trees on the left nearly 800 feet away. Look for the hanging yellow flag.

Hole 9. You will see the amateur tee after the next tee this way sign. Turn right and head up the hill for the pro tee. Hole 9 is a 535' dog leg. From the amateur tee it is a very sharp left after the opening.

Hole 10 is 270ft, but will be 585 when the long tee is put in.

Hole 11 rolls up then down a hill and to the left.

Hole 12: serious down hill 340 footer with a 75 foot elevation decrease, but don't over shoot or you end up in the creek

Hole 13: 648 foot shot along a horse fence. Do not shoot at the visible basket up on the dam, the basket is in along the brush down the path. Go on top of the dam (left side) to play the longer unmarked tournament tee (730 ft.).

Hole 14 is a signature hole, with a drop then incline that covers 670 feet. The basket is placed precariously between a downhill slope on the left and the deep water on the right.

Hole 15 is a 590 foot wide open hole with rolling hills that create a 46 feet elevation increase.

Hole 16: 46 feet elevation drop from the pro tee to the basket, 23 from the AM tee. Looks like you are throwing close to the water, but water is not really a factor.

Hole 17: This hole plays over is currently over a fallen tree and has nasty thorns protecting the pin. The basket is going to be moved shortly, and a new long tee pad will be added soon.

Hole 18: 497 foot straight shot with thorns on the left and OB over the fence on the right. Basket on a raised horse jump. It's 590 if you play the practice basket as a long 18.
